



Madinah al-Ilm and Bab al-Ilm Short Summer Courses – Dress Code

Outside of the accommodation

Boys

Boys must not wear short sleeved t-shirts, tracksuit bottoms, or other types of clothing that are inappropriate for such a course, bearing in mind the culture of the area and the places and people that will be visited. Long sleeves must be worn throughout the course, except during sports.

Boys will be advised of specific dress requirements ahead of specific programmes, such as meetings with senior scholars. In such instances, they will be expected to have alternative items of clothing at hand, such as khanzus etc.

Girls

Girls must observe full hijab including non-transparent socks and hand sleeves. Girls must wear black scarves/shellas.

Girls must also not wear make-up or apply perfume.

Inside of the accommodation

Boys

Short sleeved t-shirts are permitted inside the bedrooms and bathrooms. Shorts are not permitted. Short sleeves are not permitted anywhere outside the bedrooms and bathrooms.

Girls

Full hijaab will not need to be observed. However, girls must abstain from wearing sleeveless tops and shorts.

Students must not wear any tight-fitted clothing.
