Tableegh in Bosnia



Mahe Ramadhan 1431

The core of the activities in this holy month were taking place in our Centre, Kuća Bosanska (Bosnian home). We had 14 programmes (every second night). Each programme started with the Dua Iftitah followed by lecture namaz and iftar. The majority of the public consisted of the local Muslims. We had between 20-70 visitors each night. They had opportunity to follow the translation of the Dua Iftitah on the screen. The contents of the lectures presented were, as one of the guests noted, "both informative and inspiring". After iftars some of them presented their questions to the speakers.



The lectures were delivered mainly by Bosnian Shia zakirs. The guest speakers were Prof. Akbar Eydi, the director of Mulla Sadra Foundation and Hamid Etminan, director of the Cultural Centre in Sarajevo.







This Mahe Ramadhan, one Shia family was helped to repay their loan. One student was supported with half-year school fees. 50 meals was provided to the poor through the Bosnia Muslim charity organisation "Marhamat". One widow was provided with funds to purchase food staffs for her and her children. Two families were given cash gifts. Football tournament for boys was held on the 2nd Shawwal.







Housing project

The construction of the 3 flat building started in June this year. With the funds received so far we will be able to roof it and mount the windows and the external doors. We need about 30 000 euros to complete the project.
