
OVERVIEW

One of the most blessed days in the Islamic calendar celebrated by Muslims across the world is the occasion of Eid al-Hajj. In 2013, this celebration took place in October 2012. Each year, in keeping with the tradition of the annual Hajj (pilgrimage to Makkah) ritual of Qurbani, The World Federation facilitates the slaughtering of goats and cows (qurbani), where the meat is then distributed among the needy and poor.

This year, 556 goat and 2 cow qurbanis were arranged in Kenya, Sri Lanka and Tanzania for Eid al Hajj by The World Federation on behalf of donors from around the world.

TIMELINES

- **September 25, 2013** - Community deadline to order qurbanis
- **October 2, 2013** - The World Federation arranged for qurbanis
- **October 17 to 22, 2013**- Qurbanis were completed and the meat was distributed among the needy

In Kenya and Tanzania, goat qurbanis were arranged and the meat was distributed among the needy through these local Islamic Centres - the beneficiaries included widows, orphans and seniors so that they could take it home and cook a healthy meal for the family to share and enjoy. Most of these families cannot otherwise afford to buy meat and so the Qurbani Campaign is always very well received by the local people.
