Tuition Fees



For the purposes of tuition fees, universities in South Africa charge citizens and permanent residents from the Southern African Development Community (SADC) countries the same fees as it charges local South Africans.

The SADC member countries are: Angola, Botswana, Democratic Republic of Congo, Lesotho, Malawi, Madagascar, Mozambique, Namibia, Seychelles, South Africa, Swaziland, **Tanzania**, Zambia and Zimbabwe.

This is an advantage to Tanzanian students as they qualify for SADC fees. Students from the rest of the world are liable for international fees.
