Accreditation

Curriculum

The Certificate Nursing curriculum has been designed by the Ministry of Health and Social Welfare, together with Tanzania Nurses and Midwives Council (TNMC) and National Council for Technical Education (NACTE).

Duration



The Certificate Programme in Nursing is a 2-year programme, comprising of 4 semesters.

Programme Components

The programme is also referred to as the Enrolled Nurses' Programme and comprises of Nursing and Midwifery components.



NACTE NTA Level



The 1st year of the Certificate Programme in Nursing is a NACTE NTA Level 4, while the 2nd year is graded as a NTA Level 5 programme.

Progression

After completion of the Certificate Programme, the learner can progress into the Diploma Programme in Nursing, which is graded as NTA level 6. Completion of the Diploma Programme then opens the doors for the Bachelor's degree.

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Overview

The 2-year Certificate Programme in Nursing is divided into 4 semesters.
Each semester is of 22 weeks.
The entire Programme comprises of 19 Modules of study, and includes theoretical training as well as clinical practice sessions.
Theory classes and practical sessions are in the ratio of 1:3.
