INTRODUCTION:

The long term aim of the ZCSS is to bring about self-sufficiency within the developing world. To facilitate this, we own schools in India and support the education of needy children in other developing regions as well, through sponsoring for their school fees and general well-being. Alhamdulillah , at present ZCSS is present in India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Sri-lanka , Afghanistan, Kenya, Tanzania . Each of the ZCSS students are allocated to a particular donor, who pays a fixed amount per month and regularly receives reports on progress of the students they are sponsoring. This project has been going on for over 25 years; thousands have been sponsored over them. Some of these graduates are successful professionals today, therefore supporting their families and this scheme.
