





- The Madinah and Bab Youth Courses for 2012 were an immense success:
 - 60 students participated from Europe, North America, Africa, and Dubai



- 9 mentors were selected from Stanmore, Wessex, Hyderi, Birmingham, Toronto, Dar es Salaam, and Leicester
- The mentors were trained on a number of skills and processes to help their personal development


- For the first time in Qum, a couples' course was organised for two weeks.

Internal Tableegh: Najaf Q & A

- Islamic Education has arranged, via a community student in Najaf, to channel community questions for swift and clear answers from Ayatullah al-Uzma Sistani's office in Najaf
- This will inshallah strengthen the bond between grassroots and the Marja, and provide them with clear and accurate guidance on their fight questions



- India Office organised a boys' youth course for 13-17 year olds in May 2012
 - 39 students and 5 mentors participated
 - The youth course focused on Islamic guidance and support, social issues, personality development and team-building activities



- Following the success of the first course, a second course was arranged in May 2013
 - 40 students participated with 5 mentors






- For the first time in India, a couples' course was organised in April 2013. The course focused on:
 - The wheel of life and how to make the most of it
 - How to manage periods of change
 - Practical tips and skills for a successful family life
 - Communication
- A total of 9 couples participated

- An IT course for local Hawza students has been running since September 2012. The class graduated in April 2013. A new batch will start the next course in September 2013.
- A course for girls has been recently held in June 2013 for the first time.




Internal Tableegh: CPD





 The next CPD is planned for September 2013 on the topic of Eschatology



External Tableegh

- Afghanistan: Islamic Education provided \$12,500 to the office of Ayatullah Ishaq Fayyaz in Qum, to purchase Qur'ans and transport them to Afghanistan for the holy month of Ramadhanr 2011.
- BMMK: 2 students of BMMK were sponsored to attend Madinah and Bab Summer Course in 2012.
- Somalia: 500 books were sourced in Iran and donated to the Somali Shia community in Kenya.





External Tableegh: Sri Lanka


 Tableegh efforts continue in Sri Lanka in conjunction with Az-Zahra Association. Members of Az-Zahra Association meet with families and teach them the basics of prayer and the importance of the Shia school of thought. In the last few months, 46 families (approximately 165 people) have embraced the Shia faith.






External Tableegh: Myanmar

- Myanmar has between 10,000 20,000 Shias throughout the country. Shaykh
 Jamal Husain, a student of the Hawza in Qum, was sponsored to preach the
 values of the Ahlul Bayt (as) and to hold Majalis in Muharram in the town of
 Taunggyi. Lectures were delivered on 'Objectives of the Uprising of Imam
 Husayn (as)' in the native Burmese language to approximately 300 people.
- Shaykh Jamal also travelled to Rangoon where he lectured in Urdu.
 Approximately 5000 Shias reside in Rangoon.
- Islamic Education is now embarking upon the publication of a book in Burmese language.






External Tableegh: Kenya





External Tableegh: Pakistan

- As a result of The World Federation's 40 Islamic Centres in 40 Days Campaign and Islamic Scholars for Islamic Centres Appeal, a special Muharram programme was arranged across all Islamic Centres built by The World Federation where religious guides have been appointed. Instead of the usual sectarian issues, scholars spoke about:
 - 1. The objectives of Imam Husayn's (as) movement
 - 2. The importance of 'Sajdah' and 'Pardah'
 - 3. The role of Imam Husayn's companions and family members







Madrasah: GCSE


