What will I gain by attending this course?

Shakespeare's great political play provides fascinating insights into the challenges facing modern leaders. How can we effectively influence others? How can we survive organisational power struggles? Can we develop political intelligence without sacrificing integrity? The leaders in this story fail. We learn from their mistakes.

This programme will develop your ability to operate effectively within the political forces that underpin organisational structures. Observing and distinguishing behavioural signals, interpreting them correctly and acting with greater confidence we can engage with both emotional and political intelligence.

By exploring the characters of the play's four very different leaders - Caesar, Brutus, Cassius and Mark Antony - we learn how to balance ambition and honour, integrity and expediency in the workplace. Julius Caesar teaches us practical lessons around power, persuasion and getting things done.
