



Important instructions for Conference Participants

Please print this document and bring with you to Dubai for your records and guidance.

1. Visas:

Visas are transit for 14 days. You will have received your e-visa from Dubai Jamaat. Proceed to immigration visa counter with your e-visa. Dubai Jamaat has already paid the charges. You will have to reimburse brother Mustafa Rashid @ US\$ 100 per visa.

2. Dubai airport:

If you find your respective hotel personnel outside the terminal you will be provided transport otherwise you are requested to reach the hotel by private taxi. The hotel addresses are:

3. Hotel check-in:

Please bring with you the email you have received from Dubai Jamaat or The World Federation, confirming your hotel booking. Report to your hotel and provide your name at the reception. You will get access to your respective room. Payment to be made directly by guests on check out. Hotel may ask for and retain your original passport as security. Breakfast will be provided as complimentary by the hotel, all other hotel expenses to be borne by the guest. You are advised to request the hotel in advance for return transport to the airport.

4. Conference venue:

Conference Venue for the three days Friday 15 September to Sunday 17 September 2006 is Majma Ahlul Bayt, located in Jaffliya. The Conference will start at 8.30 am till after dinner at night as per the detail programme. Unless you are staying at one of the three hotels mentioned above, please make your own arrangements for transport to the Majma. Taxi drivers will not know the venue by name, you may explain as follows. Opposite Eid Gah, Port Rashid Road behind EPPCO. Take a left turn just before EPPCO. Find the third building on the right.

5. Transportation:

Transportation to Majma Ahlul Bayt will be provide from all the three official accommodation venues, namely Iranian Club, Imperial Residence and Dhow Palace Hotel. Buses will depart from these venues at 8.30 am for Majma Ahlul Bayt where conference will take place. If you are late and miss the bus, please make your own way, following the directions given in 4 above. Return will be arranged to the respective hotels after dinner. Lunch will be served at the conference venue.



6. Thursday 14 September at Satwa Imambargah (located in Jaffliya Area):

There will be a ZCSS Convention starting with Namaz and Lunch at 12.30 pm. The Opening programme of Majlis will start at 8.15 pm. All participants are requested to make their own way to the Imambargah, irrespective of where you may be living. From Garhoud Bridge, go towards The Trade Centre. Before passing Trade Center, take the Flyover exit towards Dhiyafa Road. At the end of the Flyover, take the immediate right turn. Once you have turned right, go straight and pass the 1st Roundabout. Approximately 50 meters down from the roundabout, you will see Satwa Imambargah on your left hand side. As there is no direct left turn, you will have to come back by making a U turn at the next Roundabout.

7. ID Badges

You will be able to collect your ID badges from Satwa Imambargah On Thursday or from Majma Ahlul Bayt from Friday onwards.

8. Dress Code

All are reminded that the World Federation expects all attendees to be suitably attired in keeping with the decorum, spirit and the practice of Sharia. This is a meeting of the leadership of the Community and hence the importance of setting standards and examples for the Community at large.

The dress code for women throughout the Conference (at all sessions including focus forums of all boards and desks and all outings) should be correct hijab, the minimum being a loose full length outer garment and a scarf. The Women's desk will be more than happy to assist and advise on the do's and don'ts on the matter.

The dress code for men is somber clothing with no sleeveless clothes and no shorts. Certain corridors, stairs, lifts at the venues will be reserved entirely for women. Men are requested to respect the requirement of privacy by the women.
