Rules and Regulations

Attendance and keen participation in all of the programmes, including proper note taking in class, is compulsory.

Students must cooperate fully as part of a group rather than following their own agendas.

Students must be punctual to all of the programmes.

Please note that if a student has a genuine reason to be late or absent from any of the programmes, he or she must inform one of the organisers about this.

Proper Islamic behaviour must be observed at all times.

Smoking is not permitted for any participant under the age of 16. For the older participants who already smoke, they will only be allowed to smoke in designated areas and only with the permission of the organisers.

Electronic devices, such as mobile phones, hand-held games and mp3 players are not permitted.

A student may leave the premises only after having gained permission from one of the organisers.

Light outs will be 11pm and will be at the discretion of the mentors.

Any activity or behaviour that may put others at risk or cause damage to the surroundings will not be tolerated.

BB guns or any other dangerous items will not be permitted to be bought during the trip or taken back home.

Disciplinary action that the organisers of the courses can take in the event of a breach of the rules and regulations (not necessarily in order):

- Verbal warning;
- Written warning, with notification to and consultation with the WF and/or the parents of the student;
- Penalization (to be imposed at the discretion of the organisers);
- Exclusion.
