


Presenting for the Fifth Executive Council Meeting



Alternatives to Current Higher Education Centres:



Online Student Directory




A directory has been prepared which includes details of all our community members who study in the UK. Students are able to register on The World Federation Student Directory through our website.

1. Hiridjee Foundation loan




2. Walji Alibhai Pradhan Loan £5,000 per student per year for

4. Ahmed Khalfan Loan scheme for AFED students the Loan is awarded to one student each year. The students receives upto a maximum of £20,000 for a post graduate degree








Education Loan Repayment Forecast for 2013







Education Loan Repayments recieved from 2007 to 2013




Total Recieved 2007 - April 2013
