3	Madaris Coordinator	We have appointed a Youth as the Madaris Co-ordinator in Europe. He works directly under the Education Committee thus being mentored by the Chair and Vice chair of the Education Committee.
4	Council Meeting Team	We have developed a small core team of youths who form part of the 6 monthly Council Meeting preparations Team. This allows them to appreciate the 'behind the scene' work as well as volunteer on the day.
5	Team Heads	We have now a number of youth heading the various sub committees.
6	Jamaat Work	We have encouraged numerous youth to engage with the Jamaat and become part of the Executive Committee. You can see examples of this in most Jamaats in Europe.
7	Youth Internship	We run an annual internship programme for some commercial organisation and hold one or two places for CoEJ. This allows the candidates to get an appreciation of the work CoEJ does and general volunteering for the community.
8	4 Questions	We gave the 4 questions posed at the last Executive Council meeting to the Youth Desk of CoEJ. They asked the same 4 questions to the Youth Leaders of Europe. Their outcome is attached.
